

ACSU Codes of conducts for Consulting companies

Employees of SAP consulting companies or similar service providers are normal members of the ACSU having all rights and obligations. ACSU will treat Consulting companies and their employees not different from other membership companies (usually SAP customers).

Consulting companies are intended as a member although they might not use SAP software solutions in their own company. Employees of Consulting companies actively working in Special Interest Groups (SIG) or related working groups are necessary for the communication process. ACSU invites consultants to enrich the discussions during the events with their own project experience and involve their own customers in the work of the ACSU rather than just passively gathering information or establishing contacts.

No consulting company shall engage in any sales activity, including direct or indirect solicitation, or conduct any other activity, contrary to the purposes and policies of ACSU. This can lead up to the membership exclusion. Examples are the systematic targeting of customers for the purpose of marketing and advertisement, company presentations in the ACSU events, the recruiting of personnel or the aggressive distribution of name cards. It is further prohibited to use the name of the ACSU to reach goals which are not consistent with the objectives of the ACSU. The usage of contact data - available only by the ACSU bodies - for the only purpose of their own company public relation is forbidden. Additionally the usage of any other type of aggressive advertisement not mentioned here is prohibited.

Members and function owners of ACSU are urged to report any breach of these rules to the Management Board. The Board will decide thoroughly about the exclusion of the membership.
